Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to update you on the government decision to place Leicester back into lockdown. Although we await detail on what the exact Leicester-specific measures will be, the Health and Social Care Secretary Matt Hancock has confirmed that, along with all non-essential retail, schools in Leicester will close this week. This arrangement will commence tomorrow so **please note that today, Tuesday, is the last day of current opening. Our schools will remain open to vulnerable children and children of critical workers, as they have done throughout.** Please rest assured that the current level of remote and online learning will continue until the end of the summer term for all year groups.

Our schools will reopen at the beginning of next term, and your child's school principal will write to you to confirm the details of these arrangements in due course.

These recent times have been particularly challenging and we would like to thank you once again for the support that you have shown your child's school over the past few months weeks and also for the commitment that you have shown to supporting your child's ongoing learning.
