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## **Additional Information:**

Topics aim to incorporate the various foundation subjects within their content however some subject areas follow their own scheme.

Literacy – EYFS and KS1 plan literacy through Read Write Inc, a variety of picture books and short stories. KS2 plan Literacy through novels linked to their topics. Grammar, Spelling, and Punctuation are also planned for against the objectives from the National Curriculum.

Maths – follows a whole school plan created by teachers with the Maths Subject Lead. This follows a Fluency, Application and Reasoning structure.

PSHE – runs through all aspects of the school as well as taught lessons. Whole school themed days/weeks include Our Values, Difference and Diversity, Healthy Schools, Antbullying, World Mental Health Day, Women in STEM.

Religious Studies – follows the Leicester City Agreed Syllabus. Festivals celebrated include Easter, Eid, Christmas, Vaisakhi and Diwali.

Physical Education – is planned for by teachers following a school overview. Coaches are used to support teachers planning, delivery and assessment.

Computing – follows the NCCE scheme. E-safety is planned through Project Involve. Coding is delivered by students from De Montfort University.

French – follows a designated scheme of work.
